I think he was talking about himself. Whatever.

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





Found this log tonight. The computer says it was from three months ago. I don't even remember having this conversation.





Right Foot Shuffle. Repeated after itself for a couple measures of just shuffling.

Left Foot Shuffle. So named because the shuffle begins with the left.

March in Place (Right). Starts off with the right.

Another Basic Step.

Right, Backtap Three Down. Backtaps should be done with the unused foot.

Left, Fronttap Three Up.

March In Place (Left).


Another Basic Step.

Rocking Horse (Up). Twist or turn involved, depending on style.

Rocking Horse (Down).

Crazy Stomps Down. Lower Corner Jumps then opposite Upper Corner Jumps. Moderate to High Air.

Up Three Lefttap.



The Transformer. Corner Jump to Side Jump to other Corner Jump to Rocking Horse Jump. Tricky.

Another Basic Step.

Left Up, Interrupted Right.

Double Down Sides.

Side Jump Freeze. Maintain the step for the duration of the arrows.

Frozen Rocking Horse.

Crazy Stomps Up. Upper Corner Jumps then opposite Lower Corner Jumps. Moderate to High Air.

Frontstage Rocker, Right.

One of a couple different variations of the basic step. Moderate stream.

Swiveling Jumping Jacks. Jumps with either twists or turns depending on style.


"I can still see the things that matter without the need for noticing the colors", he says.


MACROPOLIS CITY OUTSKIRTS HUNTERS' GLEN


MACROPOLIS CITY OUTSKIRTS INDUSTRIAL PARK
